“Our expectation was we’d need to rewrite the entire UI—a multimillion, multiyear approach,” he says. “We broached the topic during a visit to Progress headquarters and came back with some ideas about how to embed our current screens in a .NET container.”

By matching the possibilities with the ideas about a more modern UI, the proALPHA team found that almost all of the new concept could be done without rewriting everything. Three months later, they had a fully-functional first version.

Wolf also has memories of Progress co-founder and software pioneer [Mary Székely](#).

“When discussing architectural changes with our consultant Mike Omerod, we found a ‘missing link’ in dataset handling to make it much easier to handle recursive datasets,” he says. “Mike called Mary to discuss the possibilities. At the end of the call, she said, ‘I like it. Let me give it a try.’ The next morning, we had a build from her desk including a first implementation. Later, when she presented the final version, the audience gave her a round of applause.”

Remembrances

Martin Wolf tells the story of how in 2013, proALPHA faced an issue with their multi-window UI—it was loved by customers once they used it, but disliked by sales because it didn’t attract prospects at first glance. After consulting with an external design agency and key customers, proALPHA R&D launched a project for a new UI.
