

Scholarship Guidelines

The scholarship is awarded to a single recipient annually.

AWARD

An annual scholarship up to INR 1,50,000 with the exact amount to be determined based on the student's financial need at her university.



ELIGIBILITY

Requirements

The recipient of the Progress Akanksha Scholarship for Women in STEM must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. A young woman with Indian citizenship
- 2. Enrolled in the first year of college and majoring in Computer Science Engineering (CSE), Computer Science Information Technology (CSIT), or related courses
- 3. Aggregate marks secured in the 12th standard or equivalent examination must be 75% or above
- 4. Family income must not exceed INR 8,00,000

Exclusions

- 1. Progress employees, board members and their families are not eligible
- 2. Students in graduate school are not eligible

For the purpose of this scholarship, STEM is defined as computer science, software engineering, IT and/or computer information systems



SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS


Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on academic achievement, financial need, interest and experience in computer science, software engineering, IT and/or computer information systems, and personal attributes that exemplify qualities, including, but not limited to, high personal integrity, a passion for learning and spirit to seek progress and overcome challenges with grit and determination.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete applications are due on **Friday, April 11, 2025.** Please follow instructions carefully.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following materials are required. Only fully completed applications will be considered.

- 1. Completed and submitted online application
- 2. One essay is required.
 - a. Essay Prompt (500-1000 words)
 - i. Please share your passion for STEM, where it started, and what you hope to achieve. Additionally, please dedicate some of your essay to any extra-curriculars, volunteering, or community engagement you have been involved in and the impact those programs had on you.
- 3. Copy of XII Mark Sheet
- 4. Copy of Government ID/Aadhaar Card
- 5. University Admissions Letter
- 6. Proof of Family Income Certificate, BPL, or similar
- 7. Resume/CV

TIMELINE

- 1. Complete applications are due on Friday, April 11, 2025
- 2. Selected applicants will be invited for interviews in late April/early May
- 3. Scholarship recipient will be notified in June
- 4. Scholarship applicants not selected will be notified of decisions via email in late May
- 5. Scholarship recipient will be publicly announced by Progress in June









RENEWING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship recipients are eligible to renew their scholarship for up to four years in a five-year period while pursuing an undergraduate degree, provided the following requirements are met:

- 1. Submit year-end transcripts
- 2. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 7.0 on a 10.0 scale (or its equivalent)
- 3. Remain enrolled in an accredited university, college, or trade school
- 4. Maintain a major in computer science, software engineering, IT and/or computer information systems
